FROM North of Woodstock:

Follow I-81 South to Woodstock. Take exit 291 for State Route 651 toward Toms Brook . Turn left onto State Route 651. Go 1.0 mile Turn right onto US-11 south. Go 6.6 miles. Turn left onto E. Court Street. Woodstock Brewhouse will be on the left.

FROM East of Woodstock: (these directions use Culpeper as start point)

Take US 522 North to Sperryville. In Sperryville take US 211 West towards Luray. In Luray take VA Route 675 North towards Edinburg In Edinburg turn right onto US-11 North /N Main Street. Go 8 miles. Then turn right onto E. Court Street. Woodstock Brewhouse will be on the left.

FROM South of Woodstock:

Follow I-81 North to Woodstock. Take exit 283 for VA-42 toward Woodstock. Turn right onto VA-42 N/W Reservoir Road. Go 0.6 mile. Turn left onto S. Main Street. Go 1.2 mile. Turn right onto E. Court Street. Woodstock Brewhouse will be on the left.

From the Peninsula via the James River Bridge (Newport News/Hampton/Williamsburg)

- Take the James River Bridge (Route 17 South) towards Isle of Wight County.
- Take a right at the third stop light onto Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Blvd). Travel 2.8 miles.
- Take a right on Route 10/258 (Benns Church Blvd). Travel 1.9 miles.
- At third stoplight, bear right onto South Church Street. Travel 2.6 miles. The Smithfield Center will be on your right.

From the Peninsula via I-664 (Newport News/Hampton/Williamsburg)

- Take I-664 South over the Monitor-Merrimac Bridge-Tunnel.
- Take Exit 9A for the James River Bridge/Route 17. Travel 8.9 miles.
- Take a left onto Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Blvd). Travel 2.8 miles.
- Take a right onto Route 10/258 (Benns Church Blvd). Travel 1.9 miles.
- At third stoplight, bear right onto South Church Street. Travel 2.6 miles. The Smithfield Center will be on your right.

From Suffolk

- Take Main Street (Route 10/32 and Business 460) until you reach Godwin Blvd.
- Take Godwin Blvd (Route 10/32 North). Godwin Blvd turns into Benns Church Blvd once you enter Isle of Wight County. Travel a total of about 15 miles.
- Bear right onto South Church Street. (4th stoplight on Route 10) Travel 2.6 miles. The Smithfield Center will be on your right

From the East via I-64 (Chesapeake/Virginia Beach)

- Take I-64 (Inner Loop) towards Suffolk. Merge onto I-664 North.
- Take Exit 9A for the James River Bridge/Route 17. Stay on Route 17 North for about 8.9 miles.
- Take a left onto Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Blvd). Travel 2.8 miles.
- Take a right onto Route 10/258 (Benns Church Blvd). Travel 1.9 miles.
- At third stoplight, bear right onto South Church Street. Travel 2.6 miles. The Smithfield Center will be on your right.

From the Downtown Tunnel in Norfolk

- Take the Downtown Tunnel, stay on I-264 West until you get to I-664 North.
- Take I-664 North.
- Take Exit 9A for the James River Bridge/Route 17. Travel 8.9 miles.
- Take a left onto Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Blvd). Travel 2.8 miles.
- Take a right onto Route 10/258 (Benns Church Blvd). Travel 1.9 miles.
- At third stoplight, bear right onto South Church Street. Travel 2.6 miles. The Smithfield Center will be on your right.

From the South:

From the city follow Interstate 95 North to exit 92a, toward Hanover, onto VA-54 E (Patrick Henry Road).

Follow VA-54E to the end, about 5.5miles, and take a Right on US-301 towards Hanover. Hanover Tavern will be on your right-hand side, about half a mile down.

From the West:

Follow Interstate 295 S towards Washington/Norfolk to exit 41A.

Merge onto Chamberlayne Avenue / US-301/ VA-2 towards Hanover.

Follow US-301/VA-2 for 10 miles.
