DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM RICHMOND, VA

- Merge onto I-64 E via EXIT 75 toward Richmond Int'l Airport/Williamsburg/Norfolk
- Take the VA-199 E exit, EXIT 234, toward VA-646/Lightfoot. (go 0.25 miles)
- Merge onto VA-199 E. (go 6.04 miles)
- Take the exit toward VA-321/Monticello Ave. (go 0.14 miles)
- Merge onto VA-321 E/Monticello Ave via the ramp on the left toward Williamsburg. (go 0.57 miles)
- Turn left onto New Town Ave.
 - New Town Ave is 0.2 miles past Ironbound Rd
 - If you reach Courthouse St you've gone about 0.1 miles too far
- 4301 NEW TOWN AVE is on the left.
 - Your destination is just past Center St
 - If you reach Foundation St you've gone a little too

DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM NORFOLK, VA

- Merge onto I-64 W toward Naval Base/Terminal Blvd. (go 35.96 miles)
- Merge onto VA-199 W via EXIT 242A toward Williamsburg/Jamestown. (go 6.95 miles)

The **Culpeper Country Club** is located at **2100 Country Club Road** (540-825-1746) in **Culpeper, VA**.

FROM North of Culpeper:

Follow US-29 South to Culpeper.
Use the right lane to take the US-522/VA-3 ramp to Culpeper/Fredericksburg.
Turn right onto US-522 N/VA-3 W.
Go 1.3 mile Turn left onto Madison Road.
Go 0.6 mile Turn right onto Country Club Road.
Go 0.3 mile Club will be on your left.

FROM East of Culpeper:

Follow VA-3 West to Culpeper. Continue on VA-3 West when you get to Culpeper until you reach Madison Road Turn left onto Madison Road. Go 0.6 mile Turn right onto Country Club Road. Go 0.3 mile Club will be on your left.

FROM South of Culpeper:

Take US North towards Culpeper.

When you get to Culpeper use the right lane to merge onto US-29 Bus N/Madison Road via the ramp to Culpeper.

Go 1.1 Mile Turn left onto Golf Drive.

Go 0.2 mile Turn right onto Stoneybrook Lane.

Go 0.1 mile Turn left onto Country Club Road. Club will be on your left.

FROM West of Culpeper:

Take US-522 South towards Culpeper Once you reach Culpeper at the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto Sperryville Pike. Go 0.3 mile Turn right onto N. Blue Ridge Avenue Go 1.0 mile Turn right onto Madison Road Go 0.5 mile Turn right onto Country Club Road

Go 0.3 mile Club will be on your left.

Take 3rd Bedford exit (Route 714) and bare right at the end of the exit. You'll be on Route 714. Then follow the general directions below.

FROM 460 HEADED WEST:

Take the 1st Bedford exit (Route 714) and bare left at the end of the exit. You'll be headed to Route 714. Then follow the general directions below.

General Directions

Go approximately 1.5 miles and look for the skatepark on the left and next left will go into the Falling Creek complex. As you're turning you should see the Sheriff's Office on the right.

You will be approaching the Bedford County Nursing home and a roundabout. Go through the roundabout past the Nursing Home and head for the building with the green roof.

This is the Parks and Rec. building. If the front parking lot is full there's a large parking lot to the right of the building adjacent to the Falling Creek Park.

Enter by the front door and go past the first meeting room until you get to the larger Peaks room on the right.
